The Wisconsin State Fair Junior Rabbit Show is a Sanctioned Youth ARBA and WSRBA Youth Show. All ARBA and WSRBA show rules shall apply.

### GENERAL RULES

- 1) Entries: Entries, with the proper fees, must be submitted through your local county extension office. Entries sent directly to Wisconsin State Fair will not be accepted. Fair management reserves the right to close entries at any time pen capacity is reached. Entries will be processed as indicated on entry form. Wisconsin State Fair will not combine entries, change names or make other changes to original exhibitor entry information for the ARBA, WSRBA or specialty clubs. Do not make entries in Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex classes. Entries will automatically be considered for awards in those divisions.
- 2) Competition is open to any boy or girl who is carrying a rabbit project in a recognized youth organization and is 12-19 years of age as of January 1st of the current year. See “Junior General Rules and Regulations” on [www.wistatefair.com](http://www.wistatefair.com) for eligibility requirements.
- 3) All rabbits will receive the best care and protection the surroundings will afford, but they are at all times subject to the owner’s risk. No insurance will be furnished.

- 4) **Each exhibitor is limited to exhibiting 25 rabbits, with a maximum of two entries per class number.** Rabbits exhibited in the Open Rabbit Show may not be entered in the Junior Rabbit Show. All rabbits must be permanently tattooed or they will be disqualified. Tattoos must be stated on entry blank.
- 5) Once rabbits are checked in at the Fair they shall not be removed from the Fair unless it is released by the Superintendent. Any violation of this rule will result in loss of all premiums and awards.
- 6) A loading and unloading permit will be provided to pick up and drop off rabbits. These permits allow access through Gate 5 for one vehicle and up to three people to proceed directly to the Poultry & Rabbit Palace for load-in and load-out purposes only. Exhibitors intending to stay at the Fair must purchase admission and parking tickets.
- 7) **Exhibitor Expectations:** Exhibitors are responsible to feed and water their own rabbits by 9:00 am each day. Barn duty will be scheduled by the Superintendent. Failure to complete barn duties will result in loss of premiums. Barn duties include putting fresh shavings in cages, feeding, watering, sweeping and other light duties. Exhibitors are to carry their own rabbits to and from the judging table or arrange for another junior exhibitor to do so. Adults are not permitted at the show table. Animals will be called for twice. If the animal is not present, it will be disqualified from the class. Junior rabbit exhibitors are encouraged to stay in the Tommy G Thompson Youth Center during the Junior Rabbit Show.
- 8) Any rabbit showing symptoms of disease when received or during the show will be removed immediately from the show. Owner must make arrangements for picking up their ill rabbits within 8 hours of notification or rabbit will be disposed of at Superintendent's discretion.
- 9) In order to promote an attractive exhibit, all exhibitors will be required to remove their carrying cases after caging their entries. All grooming tables, rabbit carriers, etc. must be removed from the rabbit exhibit at the conclusion of judging, or forfeit any premiums awarded during the show.
- 10) Fitting is limited to the exhibitor, his/her mother, father, sister, brother, step-parent or legal guardian (with proof of relationship) or other junior rabbit exhibitor participating in the Wisconsin State Fair junior rabbit show.
- 11) Transportation premiums may be available. Please check the general rules and regulations.

#### **OWNERSHIP**

The exhibitor must be the owner of the rabbit(s) placed in competition and a violation of this rule will forfeit any premium awarded to such exhibitor. Fair management reserves the right to inspect pedigree papers or other satisfactory title of ownership as may be determined by the management. Sweepstake points may not be combined between exhibitors.

#### **SUBSTITUTION RULES**

Substitutions are permitted in the same breed, variety, color, class, age and sex of the original entry. **Substitutions are \$1.00 each and will be collected at check-in.** Be sure to check your receipt carefully. NOTE: Tattoo numbers do not appear on receipts. Therefore, make copies of original entry before sending in. In the event of a State Fair entry mistake, please call the State Fair Entry Office at 414.266.7052 to correct the changes. At check-in, substitutions can only be made for animals that have already been entered. No additional entries can be added.

#### **POINTS TO COUNT**

"Points to Count" will be calculated on the basis of 6 points times the number of rabbits in class for first place, 4 points times the number of rabbits in class for second place, 3 points times the number of rabbits in class for third place, 2 points times the number of rabbits in class for fourth place and 1 point times the number of rabbits in class for fifth place.

All Junior Fair rabbit exhibitors are encouraged to participate in Junior Showmanship. Contestants will be judged on rabbit knowledge, handling skills, appearance of the rabbit, attitude and appearance of the showperson. No study materials are permitted after check-in. Showmanship age requirements follow ARBA and WSRBA guidelines.

### Entry Fee: \$5.00

- 1) Only exhibitors in the department are eligible for the Rabbit Showmanship Contest. Entry in showmanship is required by June 30, utilizing the Wisconsin State Fair Junior Rabbit Entry Form. Entry in Showmanship must be confirmed during check-in.
- 2) Exhibitors must exhibit his/her own animal entered and checked in for one of the breed classes. The same animal must be used in all heats and finals.
- 3) Exhibitors' age as of January 1st will be used for determining age division. The Superintendent will post class order at the Fair.
- 4) The Superintendent reserves the right to break any class with more than 10 participants into heats. Exhibitors will be randomly assigned to heats. The judge will select the top showpersons in each heat (quantity at the judge's discretion) to advance to the final class for that particular age class.
- 5) Premiums for the finals will be paid on straight placing. Participants not selected to advance from preliminary heats will receive a \$5.00 premium.
- 6) Exhibitors are encouraged to wear a Wisconsin State Fair sponsored showmanship shirt if available.
