

STATE FAIR CLOTHING REVUE
Youth Participant Pre-Registration
2009 Wisconsin State Fair

Youth Participant Selection Process:

1. Each 4-H county or other organized youth group is allowed two clothing revue participants. Additional participants will be granted based on program participation. Participants must be at least 14 years of age as of January 1, 2009.
2. **To pre-register each county or group must email Lisa Fisher at lisa.fisher@wisconsin.gov by May 30, 2009.** If the county does not wish to participate an email should still be sent indicating no participation so spaces can be offered to other counties.

Pre-registration must include the following information:

- 1) Number of youth who wish to participate
- 2) Requested period of participation
- 3) Name, phone number and email of county contact person
- 4) Mailing address if different then county extension office

Participant and period selection will be made on the following criteria:

- 1) Historic participation
 - 2) Timeliness of pre-registration
 - 3) Wisconsin State Fair attempts to include all desired delegates.
3. Notification of acceptance of additional participants will be made via email in early June. Additional participants will be selected on availability and timeliness of pre-registration.
 4. In early June Wisconsin State Fair will mail the designated county contact one orientation packet for each accepted Clothing Revue participant along with one copy of all materials for their reference.
 5. Each participant must complete final registration and return all materials to the Wisconsin State Fair by June 30, 2009.

Participation Fee:

All participants will need to pay \$20 per night Youth Center Fee and complete a TGT Youth Center Registration form to receive a wristband which covers admission, lodging and three meals per day.

Participation Premium:

Youth participating at Wisconsin State Fair will receive a premium of \$15 for one or two days of participation. Youth who participate more than two days will receive a premium of \$20. A partial travel reimbursement may be available.

It is understood many parents and guardians choose to chaperone based on the acceptance of their sons and daughters. However, acceptance of Adult Facilitators will be conducted largely on a first-come basis. Please do not assume acceptance as an adult facilitator for the State Fair Clothing Revue as a result of completing the application.

A. Qualifications

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Have participated in the county youth protection and volunteer screening process.
- Have no other responsibility than Clothing Revue while at State Fair.
- Be willing to assume and carry out responsibilities independently.
- Relate well with youth ages 14-18.
- Be flexible, work well in new situations and enjoy new experiences.
- Relate well with other adult volunteers.
- Be interested in Clothing Revues and willing to share what you learn with others.
- Obtain signature of County 4-H Agent or organizational leader.

B. Responsibilities

- Responsible for all expectations listed on the State Fair adult chaperone expectation form.
- Advise participants planning and organizing Clothing Revues.
- Advise and counsel participants on personal matters as they arise.
- Encourage participants to think of ways they can share what they have learned at State Fair with others back home.

C. Participant Fee

Adult volunteer expenses for admission, meals and lodging are covered compliments of Wisconsin State Fair.

A. Qualifications

- Have attended State Fair Clothing Revue as a delegate at least one year.
- Have no other responsibility than Clothing Revue while at State Fair.
- Be willing to assume and carry out responsibilities independently.
- Relate well with youth ages 14-18.
- Be flexible, work well in new situations and enjoy new experiences.
- Relate well with adult volunteers.
- Be interested in Clothing Revue and willing to share what you learn with others back in your county.
- Obtain signature of County 4-H Agent.

B. Responsibilities

- Assist participants planning and organizing Clothing Revues.
- Advise, counsel, and help participants on personal matters as they arise.
- Encourage participants to think of ways they can share what they have learned at State Fair with others back home.
- Participate in and help facilitate workshops and special committees.
- Share ideas (but let the participants carry them out).
- Write narration cards and organize the Premiere Style Show.
- Help decorate the stage and straighten up room where activities are held.
- Help delegates with modeling techniques.
