

PHOTOGRAPHY DISPLAY WISCONSIN JUNIOR STATE FAIR

Each county may submit a maximum of *three* (3) photo entries for the State Fair Youth Expo Photography Display. Counties may choose their three photo entries at their discretion.

Participants must be between the ages 9 to 19 as of the start of the State Fair.

Photo entries must be sent to the State 4-H Office in November of the year prior. An entry in the photography display is one color print or one black-and-white print made from a negative, slide or digital image. If the photo entry is part of a multi-photo exhibit, please separate the photo from the rest of the exhibit and send the single photo selected for State Fair. Picture stories, slides, videotapes and movies are *not* acceptable. The photo must be *unmounted*.

Be sure each photo has the following information written in the center of the back of each photo.

The 2009 State Photography Display will hang in the Wisconsin Exposition Center during State Fair, along with other 4-H exhibits. All youth whose entries are displayed will receive a participation ribbon. The top 10 entries will receive a merit award ribbon following the 2009 State Fair. The top 10 entries will also be exhibited in the Wisconsin Room at the National 4-H Center in Washington, D.C., for one year and posted on the Wisconsin 4-H web site.

All photo entries become part of a permanent, portable display that will be available for use through the Cooperative Extension Media Collection after it appears at the 2009 State Fair. Photo entries are *not* returned to exhibitors as they become the property of the State 4-H Office.
