2021 TOMMY G. THOMPSON YOUTH CENTER JUNIOR SHOW LODGING PROCEDURES

Who Is Eligible to Stay in Youth Center Rooms? Rooms may be occupied only by approved VAGCs, VAICs and current Junior show exhibitors.

Room Rental Rate: All rooms (ADA accessible and Non-ADA accessible) cost **\$100 per room plus tax \$15.50: \$115.50 per night**. Room rental will be for the entire term of the respective junior shows (no single night rentals).

Youth Center meals are not included with room rental; nor are they required to be purchased. The Youth Center cafeteria will offer for purchase a morning breakfast meal and “grab and go” food items throughout the day. Breakfast meal tickets are available for purchase on the Final Room Rental Registration Form, or they may be purchased at the Youth Center front desk anytime. Breakfast meal tickets purchased in advance will be included in a room packet at Youth Center check-in and will not be mailed. “Grab and Go” food items will be available to purchase.

Fair Admission is required for anyone who stays in the Youth Center and must be purchased in addition to room rental. It is not included with room rental. Admission wristbands for the dates of the respective Junior sessions will be available for purchase in advance on the Final Room Rental Registration Form or at the Youth Center front desk at check-in. Admission wristbands purchased in advance will be included in a room packet at Youth Center check-in and will not be mailed. Persons without wristbands will not be allowed on Youth Center lodging floors.

Admission wristbands will be for the entire term of the respective junior shows (no single days).

Session One Admission Wristbands

Junior Dairy	\$20.00 per person (valid August 5 – 8)
Junior Rabbits & Breeding Gilts	\$10.00 per person (valid August 5 - 6)

Session Two Admission Wristbands

Junior Beef, Sheep & Market Swine	\$20.00 per person (valid August 9 – 12)
Junior Poultry	\$15.00 per person (valid August 11 – 13)

Occupancy in non-ADA rooms is limited to 12 people per room. A limited number of ADA rooms (6 beds) are available on a first come, first served basis. The VAGC determines who the room occupants are (only other VAGCs, VAICs or current Junior show exhibitors). A list of room occupants must be reported to the Youth Center front desk each night by 8 pm. Linens are not provided.

How Do I Rent a Room? Wisconsin State Fair approved VAGC’s are eligible to rent rooms. VAICs are eligible to rent a room if space permits. VAICs would be notified in late June if additional rooms are available. The number of rooms available to rent will be pre-determined by Wisconsin State Fair. Consideration for the number of rooms allowed per VAC include: number of group participants in 2019, number of projected group participants in 2021, distance from Wisconsin State Fair Park and past cooperation. Wisconsin State Fair will send reservation forms directly to all approved VACs in April.

The Youth Center Lodging Request Form must be returned to reserve room(s) by the approved VAC to Wisconsin State Fair with a deposit (check or money order) for the equivalent of one night's lodging per room reserved (\$115.50 per room). **Email or telephone reservations and credit card payment will not be accepted to hold a reservation.** All room rental and associated balances owed must be paid at Youth Center check-in. Reservations are not secured without a written or emailed confirmation from Wisconsin State Fair.

Final Room Rental Registration: After Junior show late entries close and final group numbers have been verified, VACs will be sent a follow-up Final Room Rental Registration form with the remaining amount owed for their room(s). This form will also contain the option to order admission wristbands and breakfast meal tickets. Returning this form with payment in full (check or money order) by July 20, 2021 will greatly speed up the Youth Center check-in process; however, the Final Room Rental Registration Form may be returned at Youth Center check-in.

Food Policy: Food may not be cooked or heated up on any electric device (Crockpots, rice cookers, coffeemakers, grills, toasters, sandwich makers, hot plates, roasters, griddles, etc.) within the Youth Center rooms. Propane tanks of any kind are not allowed within the youth center rooms. PLEASE NOTE: no alcohol is allowed in Youth Center.

Checks returned to Wisconsin State Fair from a financial institution for any reason will be charged a \$20.00 service fee. Payment must be made within 5 business days of notification from Wisconsin State Fair.
