HEALTH RECORDS

Persons exhibiting poultry at the Wisconsin State Fair shall supply a copy of Form 9-2 or 9-3, or official written evidence that their birds are pullorum-typhoid **with entries**. Poultry may not be exhibited at the Wisconsin State Fair unless accompanied by the required health forms. All copies of the documents will be retained by the State Fair Entry Office. Wisconsin State Fair will not be responsible for pullorum testing. All poultry over 4 months of age, except pigeons, shown in public exhibition shall:

Certified flock status

- a) NPIP participant or Affiliate Flock Certificate
- b) Wisconsin Tested Flock Certificate
- c) Wisconsin Associate Flock Certificate

Or

Wisconsin Individual Poultry Test Report

Individual identification must be on the test report (9-2 form)

No poultry of any type showing any evidence of disease may be exhibited. If at any time any fowl in this group show evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, it shall be **removed** from the exhibit, quarantined or harvested as directed by the State Veterinarian or the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection.

All poultry exhibited may be subject to quarantine or harvest if any contagious or infectious disease is discovered among any of the poultry in the exhibit.

JUNIOR POULTRY DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All exhibits will receive the best care and protection the surroundings will afford but they are at all times subject to the owner's risk.

- 1) Exhibitors must be 12 – 19 years of age as of January 1st and belong to a recognized youth organization.
- 2) Entries, with the proper fees, must be submitted through the local county extension office. Entries sent directly to Wisconsin State Fair will not be accepted. See the "Junior General Rules and Regulations" on www.wistatefair.com for eligibility requirements.
- 3) Exhibitors may enter up to 25 entries. Each exhibitor will be limited to **two entries per class**. Management reserves the right to close or consolidate classes.

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) All exhibitors are expected to conform to Wisconsin State Fair Junior participation and exhibition policies. Failure to comply may result in awards, auction proceeds and premium forfeiture, dismissal from grounds, being barred from immediate and/or future exhibitions. Wisconsin State Fair management reserves the right to interpret and enforce the rules and regulations, accept or reject any entry entirely, partially or conditionally. For a summary of Youth Center regulations for livestock exhibitors, refer to Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center Rules and Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center Registration located in "Junior General Rules & Regulations" at www.wistatefair.com.
- 2) All entries shall be composed of animals hatched during the current calendar year under the care and management of the exhibitor.
- 3) All birds must be marked with a numbered leg band and the number must appear on the entry blank or be submitted to the Superintendent when the birds are cooped. Pigeons must be banded with a current year seamless band.
- 4) Exhibitors are responsible to feed and water their own birds. Exhibitors must have their animals fed and watered by 9:00 am each day. Barn duty will be scheduled by the Superintendent. Failure to complete barn duties will result in loss of premiums. Barn duties include putting fresh shavings in cages, feeding, watering, sweeping and other light duties. Junior Poultry exhibitors are encouraged to stay in the Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center during the Junior Poultry Show.
- 5) Exhibitors are encouraged to be present during judging.
- 6) Poultry with any external parasites (lice, mites, fleas) will be disqualified from competition.
- 7) Showmanship entries must be made on the official entry form. Entries will not be taken at the show.
- 8) Fitting is limited to the exhibitor, his/her mother, father, sister, brother, step-parent or legal guardian (with proof of relationship) or other junior poultry exhibitor participating in the Wisconsin State Fair junior poultry show.
- 9) A loading and an unloading permit will be provided to drop off and pick up poultry. These permits allow access through Gate 5 for one vehicle and up to three people to proceed directly to the Poultry/Rabbit Palace for coop-in and coop-out purposes only. Exhibitors intending to stay at the Fair must purchase admission and parking tickets.

Eligible entries will be considered for those classes at the judge’s discretion.

Turkeys require the s.pullorum mycoplasma gallisepticum tube agglutination test if they are 6 months old or older. Individuals presenting birds for show, fair, or exhibition must show proof of disease status by presenting one of the following:

Certified flock status

- a) NPIP participant or Affiliate Flock Certificate
- b) Wisconsin Tested Flock Certificate
- c) Wisconsin Associate Flock Certificate

Or

Wisconsin Individual Poultry Test Report

Individual identification must be on the test report (9-2 form)

Poultry are required to have a negative pullorum-typhoid test within 90 days PRIOR to arrival at the fair or exhibition. Therefore, testing on the fairgrounds for admittance does not comply with Wisconsin Administrative Code ATCP 11.62 (4) (b).

Negative pullorum testing is required for sexually mature birds, which in the case of turkeys, is considered to be 6 months of age and older. Anyone testing for pullorum is to be certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection-Division of Animal Health and is to be knowledgeable in the fact that turkey pullorum testing requires the tube agglutination test and is to be conducted on turkey serum that is submitted to the Wisconsin Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory at Barron, WI.

Turkey Blood tests are not to be conducted by the rapid whole blood plate agglutination test.

Contestants will be judged on poultry knowledge, handling skills, appearance of the bird, attitude and appearance of the showperson. The Wisconsin State Fair will award a plaque to the top showperson in each division.

Entry Fee: \$5.00

- 1) Only exhibitors in the department are eligible for the Poultry Showmanship Contest. Entry in showmanship is required by June 29, utilizing the Wisconsin State Fair Junior Poultry Entry Form. Entry in Showmanship must be confirmed during check-in.
- 2) Exhibitors must exhibit his/her own animal entered and checked in for one of the breed classes. The same animal must be used in all heats and finals.
- 3) Exhibitors' age as of January 1st will be used for determining age division. Class order will be posted at the Fair.
- 4) The Superintendent reserves the right to break any class with more than 10 participants into heats. Exhibitors will be randomly assigned to heats. The judge will select the top showpersons in each heat (quantity at the judge's discretion) to advance to the final class for that particular age class.
- 5) Premiums for the finals will be paid on straight placing. Participants not selected to advance from preliminary heats will receive a \$5.00 premium.

- 6) Exhibitors are encouraged to wear a Wisconsin State Fair sponsored showmanship shirt if available.
