

STATE FAIR CLOTHING REVUE
County Confirmations of Participation
2011 Wisconsin State Fair

Each county is encouraged to nominate two (2) clothing revue participants (14 to 19 years of age at time of Fair) to participate in the Wisconsin State Fair Clothing Revue Program. Additional participant requests will be granted based on program participation. Each county has been pre-assigned a participation period which may be adjusted if participation numbers allow.

Additional participant or period change requests may be granted and confirmed based on the following criteria:

- 1) Availability
- 2) Timeliness of pre-registration
- 3) Wisconsin State Fair's attempt to include all desired delegates

Registration Process:

1. Each county **must e-mail** the following information to Lisa Talen by June 1, 2011 to confirm county participation. The e-mail serves as a verification of participation and an opportunity to request additional participants. Please see attached sheet for assignments. If a county does not wish to participate please send an e-mail indicating no participation so that spaces can be offered to other counties.

County Confirmations of Participation e-mails must include the following information:

- 1) Confirm county participation and verify assigned period
 - 2) Desired number of participants your county would like to send
 - 3) Period change requests if needed (please specify 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preference)
 - 4) Name, phone number, address and e-mail of county contact person
2. After County Confirmations of Participation e-mails are received, Wisconsin State Fair will notify the county of the accepted number of participants and their final period assignment. At this time Wisconsin State Fair will mail the designated county contact an orientation packet for each participant. The orientation packet will include all final registration materials.
 3. Once accepted, each participant must complete and return all final registration materials to the Wisconsin State Fair by June 30, 2011.

Participation Fee:

All participants must pay a \$23 per night Youth Center Fee and complete a Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center Registration form to receive a wristband, which covers admission, lodging and three meals per day in the Youth Center.

Participation Premium:

Youth participating at Wisconsin State Fair for one or two days will receive a premium of \$15. Youth who participate more than two days will receive a premium of \$20. A partial travel reimbursement may be available.

Adult Facilitators

A maximum of four (4) adult volunteers are needed for each of the four periods to chaperone and help facilitate the Clothing Revue activities. We realize many parents and guardians choose to chaperone based on the acceptance of their children, however, acceptance of Adult Facilitators will be based primarily on a first-come basis. Please do not assume acceptance as a result of completing the application.

A. Qualifications

- A minimum of 21 years of age.
- Have no other responsibility than Clothing Revue while at State Fair.
- Be willing to assume and carry out responsibilities independently.
- Relate well with youth ages 14-19 and other adults.
- Be flexible, work well in new situations and enjoy new experiences.
- Be interested in Clothing Revues and willing to share what you learn with others.
- Obtain signature of County 4-H Youth Development Staff or Youth Organization Leader.
- Completed the Wisconsin 4-H Youth Protection Program, if applicable.

B. Responsibilities

- Carefully read all pre-Fair correspondence from Wisconsin State Fair.
- Abide by all expectations listed on the State Fair adult chaperone expectation form.
- Help advise participants planning and organizing Clothing Revues.
- Counsel and assist youth participants on personal matters which may arise.
- Encourage participants to think of ways they can share what they have learned at State Fair with others back home.

C. Participant Fee

Wisconsin State Fair will provide adult volunteers with complimentary admission, meals in the Youth Center and lodging.

Teen Facilitator
2011 Wisconsin State Fair

Two (2) teen volunteer facilitators are needed for each of the four periods to guide youth at Clothing Revue activities.

A. Qualifications

- Must have completed 9th grade.
- Have attended State Fair Clothing Revue as a delegate at least one year.
- Have no other responsibility than Clothing Revue while at State Fair.
- Be willing to assume and carry out responsibilities independently.
- Relate well with youth ages 14-19 and adult volunteers.
- Be flexible, work well in new situations and enjoy new experiences.
- Be interested in Clothing Revue and willing to share what you learn with others back in your county.
- Obtain signature of County 4-H Youth Development Staff or Youth Organization Leader.

B. Responsibilities

- Carefully read all pre-Fair correspondence from Wisconsin State Fair.
- Assist participants planning and organizing Clothing Revues.
- Counsel and assist participants on personal matters as they arise.
- Encourage participants to think of ways they can share what they have learned with others back home.
- Participate in and help facilitate workshops and special committees.
- Share ideas (but let the participants carry them out).
- Write narration cards and organize the Premiere Style Show.
- Help decorate the stage and maintain room where activities are held.
- Help delegates with modeling techniques.
