A loading and an unloading permit will be provided to drop off and pick up poultry. These permits allow access through Gate 5 for one vehicle and up to 3 people to proceed directly to the Poultry/Rabbit Palace for coop-in/out purposes only. Exhibitors intending to visit the Fair before or after picking up or dropping off animals must purchase admission and parking tickets and must park in General Fair Parking lots.

There will be a limited number of rooms in the **Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center** available August 11th through the 14th. If interested, please contact the Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center, via email [reservations@wisconsin.gov](mailto:reservations@wisconsin.gov) or by phone at 414.266.7042 starting May 1, 2011. There is a limit of three rooms per reservation. A limited number of "one night only" rooms will be available. **PLEASE NOTE:** No alcohol is allowed in the Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center.

## HEALTH RECORDS

Persons exhibiting poultry at the Wisconsin State Fair must send a copy of Form 9-2 or 9-3, or official documentation their birds are pullorum-typhoid free **with their entries**. Poultry may not be exhibited at the Wisconsin State Fair unless accompanied by the required health forms. All copies of the documents will be retained by the State Fair. Wisconsin State Fair will not be responsible for pullorum testing. All poultry over 4 months of age, except pigeons, shown in public exhibition must show proof of disease status by presenting one of the following

- 1) Certified flock status
  - a) NPIP participant or Affiliate Flock Certificate
  - b) Wisconsin Tested Flock Certificate
  - c) Wisconsin Associate Flock Certificate

Or

- 2) Wisconsin Individual Poultry Test Report  
Individual identification must be on the test report (9-2 form)

Poultry with any external parasites (lice, mites, fleas) will be disqualified from competition. Birds with heavy infestation will be removed from the show at the Superintendent's and/or the Wisconsin State Fair veterinarian's discretion. All poultry exhibited may be subject to quarantine or harvest if any contagious or infectious disease is discovered among any of the poultry in the exhibit. If, at any time, any poultry shows

evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, it shall be **removed immediately** from the exhibit, quarantined or harvested as directed by the Wisconsin State Fair veterinarian or the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Representative.

- 1) All exhibits will receive the best care and protection the surroundings will afford but they are at all times subject to the owner's risk. Wisconsin State Fair Poultry Department staff will feed and water all animals while at the Fair. Poultry will have access to fresh water at all times.
- 2) Entries, with the proper fees, must be submitted to Wisconsin State Fair prior to June 30th. All poultry must be entered in the name of the owner(s). Entry forms must contain complete information including class number, breed and variety, including the Any Other Variety classes. Any entries without proper information will be returned. See the "Open General Rules and Regulations" section on [www.wistatefair.com](http://www.wistatefair.com) for additional rules.
- 3) Exhibitors may enter up to 4 entries per class and receive no more than 2 premiums per class. Birds must be entered and exhibited in the class created for that specific breed and variety. The any other variety division is solely for varieties that have no other class. Management reserves the right to consolidate classes to create competition and to add/or change judges at any time. Improper entries will be disqualified.
- 4) Substitutions can only be made in the same variety, breed and sex as the original entry and must be completed by 8:00 am Friday, August 12th. Birds exhibited in the current year's Wisconsin State Fair Junior show are ineligible to compete in the open show.
- 5) **Class Definitions:** A) Cock, Hen, O. Cock and O. Hen must be hatched prior to the calendar year shown. B) Cockerel, Pullet, Y. Cock, and Y. Hen must be hatched during the calendar year shown.
- 6) **Identification:** All poultry and pigeons must be marked with numbered leg bands. The number should appear on the entry forms or be submitted to the Superintendent when the birds are cooped. All pigeons must be seamless banded with a numbered band from a recognized banding organization in the current year.
- 7) **Cooping:** The show will be cooped in a classified manner as to variety and sex. Management reserves the right to consolidate coops.
- 8) **Judging:** Judges will disqualify birds incorrectly entered or when the specimen is not a true representative of its breed. Judges reserve the right to eliminate birds of questionable condition. Unworthy entries will not be placed by the judges. Exhibitors and spectators shall not converse with the judge during judging. Coop tags will be closed at the time of judging.  
Shows will be judged according to APA rules and regulations with the following exception:
  - a) Fowl shall be judged by the latest revised edition of the American Standard of Perfection, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association, Inc.
  - b) Pigeon placings will be by comparison and judges will use the National Pigeon Association Standards as their guide.

- 9) **New for 2011!** Runner ducks will be judged in a ring. Exhibitors must be sure their runners are banded for identification when they are returned to coops.
- 10) Exhibitors and visitors are prohibited from handling birds other than their own without the consent of the Superintendent. Violation will result in loss of all premiums.
- 11) Eggs laid at the Fair become the property of the Wisconsin State Fair and will be properly disposed of at the Superintendent's discretion.

Turkeys require the s.pullorum mycroplasma gallisepticum tube agglutination test if they are 6 months old or older. Individuals presenting birds for show, fair, or exhibition must show proof of disease status by presenting one of the following

- 1) Certified flock status
  - a) NPIP participant or Affiliate Flock Certificate
  - b) Wisconsin Tested Flock Certificate
  - c) Wisconsin Associate Flock Certificate

Or

- 2) Wisconsin Individual Poultry Test Report  
Individual identification must be on the test report (9-2 form)

Poultry are required to have a negative pullorum-typhoid test within 90 days PRIOR to arrival at the fair or exhibition. Therefore, testing on the fairgrounds for admittance does not comply with Wisconsin Administrative Code ATCP 11.62 (4) (b).

Negative pullorum testing is required for sexually mature birds, which in the case of turkeys, is considered to be 6 months of age and older. Anyone testing for pullorum is to be certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection-Division of Animal Health and is to be knowledgeable in the fact that turkey pullorum testing requires the tube agglutination test and is to be conducted on turkey serum that is submitted to the Wisconsin Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory at Barron, WI.

**Turkey Blood tests are not to be conducted by the rapid whole blood plate agglutination test.**
