A loading and unloading permit will be provided to drop off and pick up rabbits. This permit allows access through Gate 5 for one vehicle and up to three people to proceed directly to the Poultry/Rabbit Palace for load-in and load out purposes only. Exhibitors intending to visit the Fair before or after picking up or dropping off animals must purchase admission and parking tickets and must park in General Fair Parking lots.

There are a limited number of rooms in the **Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center** available August 11th through the 14th. If interested, please contact the Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center, via email reservations@wisconsin.gov or by phone at 414.266.7042. Rooms can be reserved starting May 1, 2011. There is a limit of 3 rooms per reservation and only a limited number of "one night only" rooms available. Please note no alcohol is allowed in the Tommy G Thompson Youth Center.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Wisconsin State Fair Rabbit show is sanctioned by The American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc and the Wisconsin State Rabbit Breeders Association. All premiums will be awarded strictly in accordance with the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of Perfection. Any provision not covered by these rules shall be determined by the Fair Management. The ARBA sanction number for the 2011 Open Show is DOA4407.

All exhibits will receive the best care and protection the surroundings will afford but they are at all times subject to the owner's risk. Wisconsin State Fair Rabbit Department staff will feed and water all animals while at the Fair. Rabbits will at all times have access to fresh water.

- 1) Entries will be processed as entered on the entry form. Wisconsin State Fair will not combine entries, change names or make other changes to the original entry form for the ARBA, WSRBA or specialty clubs.
- 2) Rabbits must be owned and entered by the owner(s) only. **DO NOT** enter in champion classes. Eligible entries will be considered for those classes at the judge's discretion. Wisconsin State Fair Management reserves the right to inspect pedigrees or other titles of ownership.
- 3) Substitutions are only allowed in the same breed, variety, color, class, age and sex of the original entry. **Substitutions are \$1.00 each and will be accepted at check-in.** Be sure to check your receipt

carefully. NOTE: Tattoo numbers may not appear on receipts. Therefore, make copies of original entry before sending in. In the event of a State Fair entry mistake, call the Entry Office at 414.266.7052.

- 4) Rabbits exhibited in the current year's Wisconsin State Fair Junior show are ineligible to compete in the open show.
- 5) All animals must be permanently tattooed or they will not be allowed to show. Tattoos must be stated on entry blank.
- 6) No rabbit shall be removed from exhibit until released by the Superintendent or a Wisconsin State Fair Veterinarian. Any violation of this rule may result in loss of all premiums.
- 7) **Health:** Rabbits showing any evidence of disease may not be exhibited. All rabbits exhibited may be subject to quarantine or harvest if any contagious or infectious disease is discovered among any of the rabbits in the exhibit. If at any time any rabbit shows evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, it shall be **removed immediately** from the exhibit, quarantined or harvested as directed by the Wisconsin State Fair Veterinarian or the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Representative. Owners must make arrangements for picking up their rabbit(s) within 8 hours of notice or rabbit(s) will be dispersed of at the Superintendent's discretion.
- 8) Exhibitors may enter up to 4 entries per class and receive no more than 2 premiums per class.
- 9) Only judges and Rabbit Department staff are allowed in the judging ring while judging activities are in progress.
- 10) All exhibitors are required to remove their carrying cages from Wisconsin State Fair after caging their entries. Grooming stands are only allowed in designated areas on the day of judging and must be removed at the conclusion of judging.
